

## Stody Estate proposals following announcement of The Hunworth Bell Pub closure and Residential Development

Dear Parishioner,

Having only taken the Chair role of the Parish Council in May I am disappointed that I am now having to write to you about the future of our local and only pub.

As a Parish Council we need your views on the Stody Estate proposals that were put to our last meeting on May 14th. The minutes of that meeting are on the Parish Council website and notice boards and Stody Estate followed up with a statement in writing that confirmed the plan that they had for the pub and the adjacent land. That statement is also on the website, but I have enclosed a copy.

At the meeting the Parish Council were asked whether the pub could be registered as an Asset of Community Value (ACV). We took the decision then that it was too early to decide on an ACV application and we would need to consult all residents before making a decision on whether the Parish Council should make an ACV application to North Norfolk District Council.

Enclosed is the notice of the Extraordinary Parish Council meeting on the 8th July at 19.00 hrs at Hunworth Village Hall to discuss the proposals put forward by Stody Estate at our last meeting on May 14th.

I am aware that the closure of The Hunworth Bell pub has an effect on residents and businesses in other nearby villages so anyone who has a view about the proposal is welcome to attend. I do hope you can attend and give us your views on what the Parish Council should do to represent your views.

If you are unable to attend you can email the Parish Council clerk with your views and they can be put to the meeting named or anonymously, as you wish.
